





Sanjay-Dubri Tiger Reserve comprising an Evergreen Sal, Bamboo and mixed forest span an impressive 1,674.5 square kilometers across Sidhi and Shahdol districts is a haven for wildlife. The reserve plays a crucial role in tiger conservation is home to about 20 tigers, 152 species of birds 32 species of mammals, 11 species of reptiles, 03 species of amphibian and many more, 34 species of fresh water fishes.

Unique Flora and Fauna

Madhya Pradesh's wildlife is not limited to tigers alone; the state is home to a rich tapestry of species found nowhere else in the country. Kanha National Park, another gem in the state, is famous for its thriving population of the hard-ground barasingha, a rare swamp deer. Once on the brink of extinction, dedicated conservation efforts have allowed this unique species to flourish, and visitors can often see them grazing in the park's meadows.



Moreover, Kanha is a birdwatcher's paradise, hosting over 300 species of birds, including the vibrant Indian roller, the majestic crested serpent eagle, and the rare and colorful stork-billed kingfisher. The diversity of avian life, combined with the chance to spot elusive mammals such as leopards, wild boar, and dhole (wild dogs), makes Kanha an unforgettable destination for wildlife enthusiasts.

Exploring Satpura National Park

For those seeking a different experience, Satpura National Park offers a unique perspective on Madhya Pradesh's wildlife. Unlike other parks, Satpura provides opportunities for walking safaris, allowing visitors to explore the wilderness on foot.



This immersive experience lets you connect with nature in a way that traditional jeep safaris cannot. Guided by knowledgeable naturalists, you can observe the smaller wonders of the ecosystem—the delicate footprints of a leopard, the intricate nests of birds, and the vibrant flora that thrives in the region.

The park is home to diverse wildlife, including the Indian bison (gaur), sambar deer, and an impressive array of birds. The enchanting sound of nature envelops you as you walk through the forests, with the calls of hornbills and the rustle of leaves serving as a soundtrack to your adventure.

Uncover Kuno National Park

Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh has become India's only sanctuary for cheetahs, marking a milestone in wildlife conservation. In 2022, India reintroduced cheetahs after nearly 70 years of extinction in the country. This effort involved relocating cheetahs from Namibia and South Africa to Kuno, where conservationists believe the expansive grasslands and diverse prey base offer an ideal habitat for these fast and elusive predators.

The reintroduction project not only aims to restore India's ecological balance but also to draw attention to wildlife conservation challenges. Cheetahs, listed as vulnerable due to habitat loss and human-wildlife conflict, find a refuge in Kuno's carefully monitored environment. With these big

cats roaming the Indian landscape once again, Kuno National Park has become a unique destination for wildlife enthusiasts and conservationists alike, representing a hopeful future for cheetah populations and India's biodiversity as a whole.

Other Must-Visit Wildlife Sanctuaries

How you portray Indian market for **Outbound Tourism?**

PH: India's importance as a source market for international tourism is growing. According to analyses by Skift India, spending on international travel grew by 17% annually between 2008 and 2019, four times faster than global tourism as a whole. For 2027, Skift forecasts further growth of 230% compared to 2019. This puts India in the top 5 source markets for global tourism.

In order to continue participating in the rapid growth of the Indian outbound market, the German National Tourist Board (GNTB) is systematically expanding its market activities on the subcontinent.

Shed light on strategic approaches to future market development in India.

PH: We have been working in the Indian market with a sales agency for two decades. In 2015, we initiated an India pool for the first time, which has been extremely successful in supporting the activities of German partners in India. The number of overnight stays by Indian guests in Germany rose by almost 40 percent from 693,000 to 962,000 by 2019. With a new edition of the India Pool and market-specific activities, we are building bridges between the demand from Indian travelers and the tourism offering in Germany. In view of the changing conditions - especially technological developments - we are also organizing a high-profile delegation trip with top managers from the German travel industry next spring with the GNTB

India Digital Travel Knowledge Tour.

What you would like to say about increasing importance India as a source market for German inbound tourism.

PH: The flow of

travellers from India to Germany has been growing steadily for many years. After the end of the coronavirus pandemic, Indian quests generated 826,000 overnight stays in hotels and guesthouses in 2023 - an increase of 33% compared to 2022.

With a recovery rate of 86%, the Indian market is recovering much faster from the Covid pandemic than all other Asian countries. Tourism Economics forecasts 1.6 million overnight stays from India in Germany every year by the end of the decade. The Indian market is also promising in terms of value creation. According to IPK International, the total turnover of all Indian tourists in Germany in 2023 was 900 million

The GNTB is investing in the Indian market together with the German travel industry, which is predominantly made up of SMEs, in order to increase brand awareness of Germany as a travel destination and thus tap into the market potential even more effectively.
